#### PINK SHIRT DAY FUNDRAISER

Pink shirt day is on February 28th. We are offering pink shirts as a fundraiser. A portion of the profits of these shirts will be donated back to the school to help facilitate events that promote inclusivity for all students.

#### WHAT IS PINK SHIRT DAY?

Pink Shirt Day originated in Canada in 2007 when two high school students decided to take action after witnessing a younger student being bullied for wearing a pink shirt to school. They bought & distributed pink shirts for their fellow classmates to wear, sending the message that bullying is not okay. Since then, Pink Shirt Day has become an annual event in Canada and is now celebrated in many countries worldwide.



There is absolutely no cost to the school to host this fundraiser. There are no minimum sale quantities needed. Honestly the only thing required of the school would be to share the word of this fundraiser and to distribute t-shirts

All ordering is done on our website which means no money has to be collected by the school. Payment can be made by email money transfer or credit card when they are placing the order. While placing the order, they are also instructed to list their child's name, the school and their teachers name and also which grade they are in. This information is then used to package their order individually and then put in a box labeled for their classroom.

Another thing that we are offering, that is going very well at other schools is the option to sponsor a child. As I'm sure you are aware, not all children can purchase a pink shirt due to many different reasons, financial hardship being one of them. And we believe no one should go without, especially on a day that is promoting inclusivity. This also gives family and friends who maybe don't have a child in the school system an opportunity to support the fundraiser while also helping a child who might otherwise not be able to participate. These shirts will not be labeled and can be distributed by the school as needed.

These orders will be delivered to your school on February 26th, two days before pink shirt day. On that day we will also be making the donation of 25% of the total profit generated from the sale of each shirt. You will also receive an online spreadsheet to track the total donation during the fundariser as well.

#### Donation breakdown in dollar amount:

T-shirts: \$3/each. Youth Hoodies: \$4.50/each. Adult Hoodies: \$6.50/each

While we cannot guarantee the success of a fundraiser, we are seeing the success of other schools so far and they are going very well. There's absolutely no loss to your school to run this fundraiser only the possibility of raising money to help out with cost of events for children throughout the year. The way we see it, people are buying pink shirts anyway, so why not have some of that money going right back to those very same kids! Thank you for taking the time to read this. 

Rec pass will **NOT** be reserved via email. You must call or stop in at the office.

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
Free Fundraiser for Aspen Heights School/Save On Foods North Save-On-Foods North is partnering with Aspen Heights School for a fundraiser and all you have to do is bring in your receipt from shopping at the store. Bring the receipt to the school with your child/ren's name and the teacher's name on it. Receipts can be turned in to your child's teacher or to the office.

When you shop at Save-On Foods North and turn in your receipt to the school, Save-On Foods North will give us back 5% of the sub-total of receipts submitted. For example, if we have 200 families that shop at the store once per week and spend an average of \$150 that would earn us \$6,000.00 per month in cash back. Over a full year that would equal \$78,000.

The class with the most 'shops' per month (Nov / May / June not incl.) will win a pizza party (courtesy of Save on Foods & Parent Council)





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
Indigenous Movie Screening at Carnival Cinemas.
