# FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

I would like to say thank you to all of our families for the great start that we have had to the 2023-2024 school year. We are very fortunate to have the professional and flexible staff that are in our school and we are happy to have 2 classes of every grade this year.

Please continue to be involved in your child's education and our school. There are many ways to stay involved. Contact their teacher if you have any questions or concerns shows your child that you are interested in their learning and want to be involved.

Volunteering in the school is a great way to participate in your child's education and show them you support their learning. Spend time talking about what they did in the school that day. The old question of "What did you do in school today?" almost always gives a shrug for an answer. Try asking "What was one thing that made you smile in school today?" or "What was one thing that surprised you?" Another question you could ask would be "What would you like to learn more about?"

Take them shopping and talk about how much things cost plus how you decide what to buy. Talk about cost and value. If something costs less but doesn't work as well it may not be the best buy for you.

Lastly, read to your child. One of the best ways to help your child to read is to read to them. Read stories more than once, talk about what they may have noticed the second time that they didn't notice the first time. Reading out loud is also very time efficient if you have more than one child because you can read to all of them at the same time. For writing, encourage your child to write to a family member. Write a postcard, email or letter to them. Make lists of Christmas gifts they would like. Write Christmas cards. Remind them that the purpose of writing is so others can read.


