





Dear parents / guardians,

Red Deer Public School CADO (Central Alberta DELF Office) will be offering the DELF exam (Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française) to all students in grade 12 French Immersion, FSL30/IB and FSL 30. This exam evaluates the four French language competencies. As a group, students begin with the oral and reading comprehension test, followed by the written production exam (total 3 hours). Students are tested individually in oral production. For the oral production, students choose the subject they would like to prepare for 30 minutes from a pool of 12 topics. Then a 20-minute interview is set up for each student. The DELF is an internationally recognized diploma of second language learners in over 175 countries. The level achieved by the students is proof of their ability in their second language and allows students to be more confident and aware of their strengths and weaknesses, and to be positive about their own ability to use the French language in real life situations.
