

Assurance Survey



As in previous years, the Ministry of Education will conduct its annual satisfaction telephone and online surveys to collect public and participant perceptions of Alberta's education system.

This <u>anonymous parent survey</u> provides us with important information on the areas where you believe your child's school is doing well in and areas where we could improve. Although the surveys are anonymous, there is a random access code for you to use that correlates to Oriole Park School so the data (your responses) are tied to our school. Principals do NOT have access to individual responses – all information goes to Alberta Ed. Alberta Education will be mailing the <u>survey</u> to parents of students in Grades 4, 7 and 10 via Canada Post along with a Random Access Code (for anonymity) and a QR code for accessing the <u>survey online</u>.

Parents/guardians needing to replace their Random Access Code can contact System

 student, school name (Ecole Oriole Park), school authority name (Red Deer Public School

Division). The school does NOT provide parent RAC's.

Students in Grade 4 have completed the survey at OP School over the last week as per Government mandate. Teachers will complete the survey at the February Staff Learning Day.

Kerry Wood Book Launch

OP School is honored to have been chosen to collaborate with the Red Deer Historical Society, the City of Red Deer, and Kerry Wood Family as they have embarked on a project to re-write / re-imagine four of Kerry Woods' books.

On January 31, our school welcomed Mr. Mark Collings, Destination History, Mr. Clare Butterfly (Red Deer Historical Society), Rondo Wood (Kerry Wood's Daughter), Emma Guido and Holly Mayoh (Book Leads on re-design & artistic work) as our school gathered to learn about the process and work involved in taking the original books and re-writing them for younger readers.

Kerry Woods' books were originally intended for audiences of 11 - 14 year olds. Holly Mayoh will take the books and re-write them for a younger audience - along with Emma Guido's artistic work to provide pictures for clarity that is geared towards a younger audience of 6 -8 year olds. Our Oriole Park Students will be involved in the process of reading the original books and then the re-vamped versions to ensure the story is not lost in translation.





Students will be learning about more than just reading through this collaboration. There are career paths to discuss - proofreading, editing, production, artistic work, writing, cover design, printing, etc.

As Literacy is both a RDPSD goal and an Oriole Park School goal, we welcome opportunities such as this to celebrate reading as well as to celebrate local talent. Before his passing in 1998, Kerry Wood had written 28 books of which we will focus on four of the books in this collaboration.

The alignment of this project with our Young Writers' and Creators' Conference is also exciting. Oriole Park School is hosting the 33rd Annual Young Writers' and Creators' Conference on April 26, 2024 which brings other Alberta authors to our school to share strategies for story-writing and enhance literacy and writing skills for our RDPSD students.

Young Writers' & Creators' Conference 2024

Oriole Park School has been the host school of the Young Writers' and Creators' Conference for 33 years! On April 26, 2024, Grade 4, 5 & 6 students from across Red Deer will be invited to OP for a day of literacy, creating, writing, learning, exploring, drama, baking & cooking, technology learning, and artistic work across a variety of mediums.

We have 6 renowned Alberta Authors, 5 technology gurus, 5 Creators, Bakers, Artistic / Drawing &/or Drama experts, and 2 Presenters with a First Nations focus coming to offer multiple sessions to the student attendees. All students must take at least one writing session and will spend the day learning about story and character development and refining their skills in a variety of areas.




