#### **Message from the Office**

Happy New Year 2024 to all our OP Families! What a wonderful Christmas Holiday break we all had - refreshed, rejuvenated, re-energized, and ready to tackle on the last 6 months of the school year together! We hope you all had a wonderful holiday season filled with lots of family time, games, outside time, reading, and general family fun.

January will see our skating unit begin in Phys Ed classes (Grades 1 - 5). If you haven't already - ensure you try on your child's skates to ensure they fit & teach them how to tie their laces/do up their buckles. We will be <a href="seeking">seeking</a> volunteers</a> to help tie skates throughout the day - so if you're able to help out, <a href="please fill out this form">please fill out this form</a> to let us know your availability. Students typically go out once/week for 1 hour to skate and you are most welcome to come and help at a time where you can watch your child skate (no hockey sticks/pucks allowed during skating time).

The weather looks like we are in for a bit of a change. Typically when the temperature with windchill dips below -20 to -22, we stay indoors. Children should still be dressed for winter play outside as the temperature can fluctuate during the day and it is healthier for their bodies and brains to get outside and play in the fresh air. We have an on-site weather station that directs our Admin decision as to indoor recesses. Dress in layers!

As we look to the last half of the school year, our focus on Literacy and Numeracy continues. Ensuring regular attendance and additional reading time at home will also foster a positive learning environment and connection to school for increased academic success. **UPDATE:** OP Food Hamper Drive




