- Learning gaps following the last 20 months - \$1M set aside for mental health and learning supports to address those gaps.

### School Report

- Book Fair haven't had one in two years. Usually make about \$2000. Despite virtual conferences, we typically have a good turnout with bookfair. Kids to make wish list after going through book fair on Tuesday and bring home to share. Then parents can send money to school on Wednesday, Dec 8 if they want to fulfill their wish list. Parents will have the opportunity to go through the book fair themselves on Thursday, Dec 9 in the multi-purpose room from 1-7pm.
- December parent/teacher interviews will be virtual.
- Learning Loss program grade 2s and 3s assessed and identified those that have fallen behind and getting targeted support. We'll hire a person (maybe 1 ½) to address and provide ½ hour each of numeracy and literacy for these students. Proposal awaiting funding approval.
- LLI prevention program. 6 people are literacy specialists in district. One of them, Kim Johnson (former teacher at our school) just finished working with our first group, and we're seeing great results. Our Learning Assistance Teacher (LAT) is now full time. WE have a strong program in place. There are also others helping out with this program.

#### **Chair Report**

- CAC - new building on Red Deer Poly land. 3 floors - AHS on the first floor to help children being released from hospital. 24/7 building. Mental health and addiction treatment for youth to use space on 2nd floor. 3rd floor is the CAC among others. A building and organization that is sustainable and not reliant on government funding. Youth in Central Alberta will hugely benefit. Hopeful to be in ground March 15, 2022 and opening its doors one year later.
